Request for Volunteers

The Junior League of Topeka is now accepting requests for volunteer-based projects from community organizations which can be completed by League members during the course of several hours. These “Immediate Impact” projects may include, but are not limited to, activities such as: painting, cleaning up a park, or serving a meal. The goal is to provide Topeka community organizations with a short, efficient, and effective, volunteer blitz from our talented and professional membership. Volunteer requests should have an impact on child welfare as impacted by community instability or violence and should not be to support fundraising efforts.

The League is offering the volunteer services of its membership to community organizations. The League is *not* offering any financial contributions to projects. To be considered for financial and volunteer support please consider applying for our [annual community partnership](#).

The League has an active membership of approximately sixty women in the Topeka community, and is focused on promoting volunteerism, developing the potential of women, and improving the community through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. As such, the League aspires to complete at least four Immediate Impact projects per year, but the frequency and timing of such projects depends on many factors.

The League reviews proposals at all times. Responses to proposals will be sent out within 45 days of submission. All accepted projects must serve the Topeka, Kansas, community; all partnering organizations must agree to indemnify the League and its volunteers; all accepted projects must further the goals of the Junior League of Topeka. The League reserves the right to deny any proposal for any reason the League deems appropriate.
